What We Can Do for Students at W. A. Day...

WA Day Elementary School has developed structures and processes to support teachers in meeting the diverse needs of students in an inclusive learning environment. We have established a response to intervention system that utilizes a universal screening of students against benchmark standards at checkpoints throughout the year in order to proactively identify students who are at risk and put supports in place as quickly as possible.

The Learning Support Team meet on a weekly basis to discuss and put into action, plans to support our students who may be experiencing academic, social-emotional and/or behavioral challenges.

Classroom teachers are invited to attend monthly team meetings to collaborate in planning for student success.



Learning Support Teacher, Leanne Feller is our team leader. She is the key contact for parents and teachers who have questions or concerns about our exceptional learners. She advocates for inclusive programming, organizes case conferences, and arranges for academic and other assessments. She oversees all of our Individual Program Planning (IPP) and Program Unit Funding (PUF) for preschool and kindergarten. Mrs. Feller also provides direct classroom support to assist in meeting the needs of our students.



Family School Liaison Counsellor, Karen Sparkes provides counseling and support to individual students or in groups. She strives to enhance family situations through support, education and referrals. She is a member on the school-based threat assessment team and post-crisis response team. She also collaborates in providing character education and social skills programming.

FNMI Teacher, Chiyoko Kensley. At WA Day we have a FNMI teacher to support teachers and students with the infusion of Blackfoot history, culture and traditions into curriculum by providing resources and background in histories, culture, protocols and language.

Child and Youth Care Workers, Sandra Lamouche (FNMI) and Vern Megli provide mentorship, behavior support, conflict resolution, special programs and classroom support.
